Timely action and filing of appeals in the District Courts.

It has been observed that some of the appeals filed by the Board in the District Courts are being dismissed on the ground of limitation. It has further been observed that the delay for filing the appeals is caused due to permission for engagement of counsel and sending the case to the Board whether the case is fit for filing the appeal or not. After careful consideration it has been decided that you may file the appeal after obtaining the legal opinion from the counsel engaged in Lower Court by engaging the same counsel and then send the case for post facto approval. In case you feel that the case is not fit for filing appeal, then you should refer the case to head office for final decision. These instructions would be applicable upto the level of District Courts only.
