Subject: Construction of Retaining Wall along Rural Link Roads.

As per present policy of the Board, the Retaining Walls along the ponds are to be constructed by the Development and Panchayats Department. But practically these are not being constructed as per requirement, due to which the roads passing along the ponds damage frequently. The construction of the Retaining Wall is necessary to save recurring expenditure on the repairs and for keeping the roads traffic worthy.

Now it has been decided by the Government vide orders dated 30-06-2010 that the construction of Retaining Wall along ponds, wherever required, shall be taken up by the Board during construction/repair of the road. Accordingly, you are directed to ensure that provision of Retaining Wall, as and where required, should be taken in the estimate while seeking Administrative Approval. The concerned E.E. and S.E. will certify that "The provision of Retaining Wall taken in the estimate is minimum & essentially required for safety & stability of the road and the design adopted is structurally safe and economical."
