

**HARYANA STATE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING BOARD,

NOTIFICATION

Dated: 29.02.2024

No. HSAMB/ME-I-A-4-2024/ 14316 . In exercise of the powers conferred by Rule 29(1) of the Haryana Agricultural Produce Markets (General) Rules, 1962 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board hereby levy a fee on the dealer of fruits and vegetables of the Schedule in the notified market area at the following rate:-

A. Lump-sum fee for category (i) and (iii) licensees per year:

Sr. No.	Category of license	Lump-sum fee per license per year (in Rs.)
1	(i) A and (i) B	70,000
2	(iii)	7,300

B. A fee on the existing licensees of category (ii) per year with the following two options:

- I. The levy of lump-sum fee on the basis of average of market fee deposited for the last two years (2021-22 and 2022-23) to be paid in four equal installments on quarterly basis in advance.

OR

- II. As per existing system i.e. 1% on ad-valorem basis.

C. For new/ fresh licensees of category (ii), lump-sum fees on fruit and vegetable is levied as given below:-

Sr. No.	Category of MC	Lump-sum fee per year
1	District level category A (Panchkula, Gurugram, Faridabad, Karnal, Ambala City, Panipat, Sonipat, Yamunanagar, Hisar, Sirsa and Thanesar)	110000
2	District level category B (Jind, Rohtak, Fatehabad, Kaithal, Bhiwani, Rewari, Palwal, Jhajjar, Ch. Dadri, Narnaul and Nuh)	90000
3	Tehsil level	41000
4	Sub-Tehsil level	31000
5	Small Town/ Rural level	21000

The standard operating procedure for levy of the fees is given as under:-

1. All licensees who have obtained license for the purchase, sale, storage or processing of agricultural produce of the Schedule under this Act shall submit an

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application/ declaration to the Secretary of the concerned Market Committee every year in attached performa and shall deposit the fee after its approval.

2. The Secretary Market Committee shall verify the contents of the application and record his decision in writing.

3. The lump-sum fee shall be calculated on the basis of average of market fees deposited for the last two years.

4. The record of fee shall be maintained by the concerned Market Committee.

5. The Secretary Market Committee shall after making such verification in the next seven days and on being satisfied about the correctness of the intimation shall order to deposit the respective lump-sum fee and to update the record maintained by the Market Committee.

6. (a) The lump-sum fee on agricultural produce shall be deposited for each financial year or quarter(s) including the fee of the quarter in which application has been submitted.

(b) The application/ declaration for depositing the lump-sum fee for the next financial year shall be made by 31st March every year.

(c) Provided that 30 days period of grace will be allowed for submitting the application i.e. till 30th April.

(d) The Secretary Market Committee shall accept the declaration made within 30 days after the date of expiry of grace period alongwith penalty equal to the 20% of due lump-sum to be deposited on fruits and vegetables.

(e) In case, a fresh application is received in any month of a quarter, the full fee shall be payable for that quarter including lump-sum fee for the remaining financial year on the above prescribed rates.

(f) For the current financial year, the self certified application shall be submitted by 15.03.2024 along with relevant lump-sum fee. The market fee/ lump-sum fee already deposited by the applicant during financial year 2023-24, shall be adjustable. Only difference of the fee shall be payable in such cases. However, refund in excess of fees paid shall not be allowed in any case.


7. The Secretary Market Committee shall provide the details of all such licensees of fruits and vegetables to the concerned D.M.E.O as well as Head Office within 15 days of the acceptance of application/ declaration.

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8. In case, any licensee is found to doing the purchase, sale, storage or processing of fruits and vegetable without depositing the due fee, the Secretary of concerned Market Committee shall take action as per provisions of Section 37 of the H.A.P.M. Act, 1961 on the basis of his turnover.

9. In case, any dealer purchases, sells, processes any agricultural produce without a license in a notified market area, the Secretary of concerned Market Committee shall take further action as per Bye-law 11(6) of the Market Committees Bye-laws.


10. The license shall not be treated as closed unless intimation in writing is made to the concerned Market Committee in advance.
